The plan will be for 10-15 students who will host in Centerville homes during the school year and then travel to Bad ZWischenahn after Centerville is out for spring and Germany is still finishing up the year. Dates will be confirmed at a later time.

Emily is in contact with Steffi in Germany, and both are excited to plan these exchanges. The job of the Sister City Committee will be to co-ordinate field trips, a welcoming party, and a final party while the German students spend at least 2 weeks in school at Centerville and maybe a third week traveling (usually Washington, D. C. or New York City. We will also assist with transportation if needed.

These exchanges make quite an impact on the students on both sides of the Ocean. They are the international travelers of the future. As we continue these exchanges, we will be embarking on our 6th student exchange. They will be biannual events.
