 - A purchase order shall be awarded based on the City's assessment of lowest and best bid and reserves the right to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any or all bids, based exclusively on the judgment of the City.
- 2. Proposals shall be submitted on the YANKEE TRACE CLUBHOUSE INTERIOR PAINTING Bidder's Proposal sheets enclosed. All information must be filled in on the Proposal sheets. All proposals must be signed. Failure to sign a proposal will result in its rejection.
- 3.
