A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO AS TO WATER STORAGE TANKS TO BE LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Montgomery County, Ohio currently owns a water storage tank ("Tank 1") located within the City located on 1742 South Metro Parkway ("Subject Premises") that is used to supply water to residents and businesses located within the City; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to build a second water storage tank ("Tank 2") on or about the Subject Premises approximately 1-2 years from the date of a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"); and


WHEREAS, the County and the City mutually desire to enter into the MOU in order to establish a framework for future Water Storage Tank logo negotiations for Tank 1 and Tank 2.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Centerville, be and is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with Montgomery County regarding two water storage tanks located within the City of Centerville, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
