A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE TO APPLY FOR AN OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (ODNR) GRANT FOR PUBLIC RECREATION PURPOSES FOR STUBB'S PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR), administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through Recreational Trails Program (RTP) and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF); and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville, Ohio, desires financial assistance under either the RTP or COTF Program for Stubb's Park.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

- Section 1. That the City of Centerville City Council approves of the filing of an application for either the RTP or COTF programs for financial assistance for Stubb's Park.
- Section 2. That the City Manager and/or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.
- Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to enter into any agreements necessary to facilitate such funding.
- Section 4. That the City of Centerville does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of either the RTP or COTF Program.
- Section 5. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
