CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Bill Surr ON THE 28th DAY OF January, 2019.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CURRENT SECTION 648.11 "PANHANDLING" OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, Section 648.11 of the Municipal Code of the City of Centerville regulates panhandling within the City in a manner which is no longer permissible under federal law as interpreted by various court decisions; and


WHEREAS, the City Council had determined that it would be in the best interests of the City to repeal Section 648.11 of the Municipal Code.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 648.11 "Panhandling" of the Municipal Code of the City of Centerville is hereby repealed.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
