

ORDINANCE NO. 32-19

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER JoAnne Rau ON THE 16th DAY OF December, 2019.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE CREATION OF THE SPECIAL ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS REVENUE FUND.

WHEREAS, Section 5705.12 of the Ohio Revised Code grants permission to the taxing authority of a subdivision to establish special funds; and

WHEREAS, Centerville City Council passed Ordinance No. 22-18 to proceed with a project fund for the Gateway Lofts Centerville, LLC project as a special energy improvement project; and

WHEREAS, special assessments for the costs of the project are to be deposited with the City; and

WHEREAS, a special fund is needed to properly account for such deposits and related expenditures.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That there is established the Special Energy Improvement Projects Revenue Fund, a special revenue fund.

Section 2. That all proceeds from the special assessment for the Gateway Lofts Centerville, LLC project be receipted into the Special Energy Improvement Projects Revenue Fund.


Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact of the immediate necessity to facilitate the creation of a revenue account for the project. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption in accordance with Section 5.05 of the Charter of the City.
