

ORDINANCE NO. 08-18

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER John Beale ON THE 19<sup>th</sup> DAY OF February, 2018.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING NEW SECTION 204.03 OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO DESIGNATE THE RED HORSE CHESTNUT OR AESCULUS X CARNEA 'BRIOTII' AS THE CITY TREE.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> year as an incorporated city in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City takes pride in having been named a "Tree City USA" for over thirty years; and

WHEREAS, as part of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration and the Tree City USA designation, it is determined that having a city tree designation is desirable; and


WHEREAS, the City Beautiful Commission of the City of Centerville and the City's staff arborists have recommended the Red Horse Chestnut also known by its botanical name, Aesculus x carnea 'Briotii', as an appropriate tree for the City.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Centerville hereby designates the Red Horse Chestnut or Aesculus x carnea 'Briotii' as the official tree for the City of Centerville and urges all citizens to plant said tree on their premises as a community project for the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


