

ORDINANCE NO. 11-18

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Bill Luvu ON THE 19th DAY
OF March, 2018.

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE ADMINISTRATIVE NON-SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 8.11, EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS, OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, Centerville Municipal Charter Article XII, Section 12.04(d) allows the City Council to make non-substantive revisions to the Charter limited to errors of grammar, sentence construction, standardization of similar modification, change, or correction without affecting the meaning; and

WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 8.11 of the Charter currently reads as follows:

To meet a public emergency affecting life, health, safety, property or the public welfare, the Council may make emergency appropriations. Such appropriations may be made an emergency ordinance in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.05. To the extent that there are no available unappropriated revenues to meet such appropriations, the Council may by such emergency ordinance authorize the issuance of emergency notes, which may be renewed from time to time, but the emergency notes and renewals of any fiscal year shall be paid not later than the last day of the fiscal year next succeeding that in which the emergency appropriation was made; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Article VIII, Section 8.11 contains such a non-substantive error that needs correction; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Law reviewed and approved this non-substantive change and has determined that such revision does not change the meaning or substance of the Charter.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
HEREBY ORDAINS:


Section 1. That the following amendment to Article VIII, Section 8.11 of the Centerville Municipal Charter is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *italics* and text to be deleted in ~~strikeout~~ as provided in Sections 5.02 and 12.04 of the Centerville Charter:

To meet a public emergency affecting life, health, safety, property or the public welfare, the Council may make emergency appropriations. Such appropriations may be made *by* an emergency ordinance in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.05. To the extent that there are no available unappropriated revenues to meet such appropriations, the Council may by such emergency ordinance authorize the issuance of emergency notes, which may be renewed from time to time, but the emergency notes and renewals of any fiscal year shall be paid not later than the last day of the fiscal year next succeeding that in which the emergency appropriation was made.

Section 2. That this Ordinance was adopted upon vote of no less than five (5) members of City Council.


Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


