

ORDINANCE NO. 07-17

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Jeanne Rau ON THE 20th DAY OF March, 2017.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 210.02, ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS, OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE TO DESIGNATE THE NEWSPAPERS OF GENERAL CIRCULATION.

WHEREAS, Chapter 210 of the Centerville Municipal Code establishes competitive bidding procedures for the purchase of supplies, materials, and labor for the City of Centerville; and

WHEREAS, Section 210.02 sets forth the procedures for advertisement; and

WHEREAS, there have been some changes in the newspaper availability in the City of Centerville.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the following amendment to Section 210.02 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *italics* and text to be deleted in ~~strikeout~~ as provided in Section 5.02 of the Centerville Charter:


210.02 ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS.

(a) The Manager shall cause the advertisement for bids to be published once each week, for not less than two weeks nor more than four weeks, in a newspaper of general circulation within the City.

(b) *Either Both* the Dayton Daily News or ~~the Centerville-Bellbrook Times~~ *the Centerville Dispatch* are hereby designated as newspapers of general circulation for public bidding purposes for the City.


Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact of the immediate necessity for the City's bidding procedures to continue within the City. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
