**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND
SECTION 844.06, MOBILE FOOD VEHICLE
VENDORS, LICENSE FEE, OF THE
CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE TO
REDUCE THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE
REQUIRED UNDER THE MOBILE FOOD
VEHICLE REGULATIONS.**

WHEREAS, the City had enacted regulations in the Centerville Municipal Code for food vending vehicles in the public right-of-way, private and/or public property; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to revise the requirements for licensure by reducing the license fee required by vendors; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it be in the best interests of the City to reduce the license fee charged to vendors.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the following amendment to Section 844.06 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby enacted as follows with new language to be added in *italics* and text to be deleted in ~~strikeout~~ as provided in Section 5.02 of the Centerville Charter:

844.06 LICENSE FEE

All vendors licensed under this Chapter shall pay an annual license fee of ~~two-hundred~~ *fifty* dollars (~~\$200.00~~*50.00*).

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact of the immediate necessity to address vendors' request during the upcoming 2016 season for mobile food vendors. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
