Keep it simple!


Current Ohio law requires that everyone must contact the Ohio Utilities Protection Service at least 48 hours but no more than 10 working days (excluding weekends and legal holidays) prior to beginning ANY digging project.

If you have a personal computer and internet access, you now have the ability to enter excavation notices remotely through e-dig, O.U.P.S.' internet-based ticket entry system for homeowners.

With just the click of a mouse, you can log onto e-dig to enter single-address locations and see which utilities will be notified in your area. It's a simple process!

How does it work?

- Log onto e-dig and enter your excavation request
- Wait 48 hours (excluding weekends and legal holidays) after e-mail confirmation, for utilities to mark
- Respect the marks
- Dig with care



What information will you need?

- Your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number and email address
- County and city or township in which the excavation will be performed
- Physical address or location of where the excavation will occur
- Nearest connecting street to the work site
- Location on property where excavation will occur (front, side, rear, etc.)
- Approximate distance off of the road that the excavation will occur
- Type of work
