## ORDINANCE NO. 17-11 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Brooks Conyston ON THE 2/st DAY OF Townsen, 2011.

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF A PLATTED UTILITY EASEMENT LOCATED ON LOT NUMBER 3 AND 4 OF THE PARK ESTATES RECORD PLAN AND ADDRESSED AS 2267 JAIME ROSE WAY.

WHEREAS, there exists a public utility easement on lots 3 and 4 of the Park Estates Record Plan; and

WHEREAS, Bradley Judge, Judge Engineering Company, has petitioned on behalf of property owners, Lisa Hanauer and Susan Spiegel, to vacate a portion of this easement as depicted in "Exhibit A" attached to this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the property owners' petition includes Release of Easement Affidavits from the Dayton Power and Light Company, Montgomery County Water Services, The Ohio Bell Telephone Company, DBA AT&T, Time Warner Cable, L.P. and Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Incorporated; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has reviewed the application in order to make a recommendation to Council to approve the petition to vacate; and

WHEREAS, the applicants, being the only abutting landowners, have given written consent to the proposed action of Council; and

WHEREAS, this application to vacate is in compliance with Article 5.11 (G) of the Centerville Unified Development Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Article 5.11 (G) of the Centerville Unified Development Ordinance, the City of Centerville does hereby release, quit claim and surrender to Lisa Hanauer and Susan Spiegel, their successors and assignees, all such right, title and interest in said real estate by virtue of an easement granted to Public Utilities by dedication dated January 28, 1992 and recorded in Plat Book 148, page 44, Montgomery County Records. Said real estate known and more particularly described as follows:

- 1. Lots 3 and 4 of Park Estates, as recorded in Plat Book 148, Page 44 of the Plat Records of Montgomery County, Ohio, and addressed as 2267 Jaime Rose Way.
- 2. The portion of said easement to be released is depicted on the attachment, "Exhibit A", incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.


