## ORDINANCE NO. DZ-10

## **CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO**

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ENACTING A SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MILES PER HOUR ON CLYO ROAD AND PARAGON ROAD WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND A SPEED LIMIT OF 45 MILES PER HOUR ON SOCIAL ROW ROAD WITHIN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, § 4511.21 (J) Ohio Revised Code provides that local authorities, by ordinance, may authorize reasonable higher speed limits upon through highways between widely spaced intersections in a municipality; and

WHEREAS, because of a technicality in the Ohio Revised Code, the statutory speed limit is 25 miles per hour on the newly constructed section of Clyo Road in Greene County as well as on Paragon Road and Social Row Road within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville, Ohio finds it in the best interest of the City to establish higher prima-facie speed limits in these areas that are more appropriate for their use, design and relevant characteristics, as well as consistency with adjoining segments of the roadways.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The prima-facie speed limit on Clyo Road in Greene County in the jurisdiction of the City of Centerville shall be 35 miles per hour to establish a consistent speed limit for that street for its entire length within the city limits.

<u>Section 2.</u> The prima-facie speed limit on Paragon Road in the jurisdiction of the City of Centerville shall be 35 miles per hour.

<u>Section 3.</u> The prima-facie speed limit on Social Row Road in the jurisdiction of the City of Centerville shall be 45 miles per hour.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public health, safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City desires to insure that posted speed limits are consistent with current City speed limits and speed limit postings.
