**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
TO REQUIRE ACCESS TO TOILET FACILITIES AT  
BUILDING SITES.**

WHEREAS, §1926.51(c) of the Code of Federal Regulations requires toilet facilities at construction sites; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code presently has no similar requirement; and

WHEREAS, this Council hereby determines that the Municipal Code should be amended to include such a requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following section:


**1422.04 ACCESS TO TOILET FACILITIES**

All building sites for principal structures shall have ready access to adequate toilet facilities. Said toilet facilities shall be in place before the building floor or any wall is in place. Said toilet facilities shall normally be on-site, but they may be located up to 300 feet away if written permission is on file at the job site for use of said facilities.

For purposes of this section, "building site" means a lot upon which there are no permanent buildings.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
