

ORDINANCE NO. 8-02

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER James E. Singer ON THE 17th DAY OF June, 2002.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 414.10 OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager can now designate the intersections where right turns on red are prohibited by issuing traffic orders; and

WHEREAS, this authority now residing in the City Manager eliminates the need for §414.10 of the Centerville Municipal Code which prohibits right turns on red for the intersections designated therein; and

WHEREAS, efficiency of government will be promoted by the repeal of said section;

NOW THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That §414.10 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
