## ORDINANCE NO. 41-00 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Susan W. Luneacl ON THE 18th DAY OF December, 2000

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERSONNEL MANUALS OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville previously adopted personnel manuals for its employees at the Golf Club at Yankee Trace and for all other City employees; and

WHEREAS, experience has dictated that certain changes should be made to said manuals.

NOW THEREFORE,

## THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Yankee Trace Manual is hereby amended at page 10 as follows:

<u>Full-time</u>: Appointment to a position which is defined as "full-time" at the time of appointment. In general, these are positions for which the hours of work are expected to be forty (40) twenty-five (25) hours per week, year round during the months of March through December.

Section 2. That the Regular Manual for all non-Yankee Trace employees shall be amended as follows:

Section 4.00 C on page 44 relating to Sick Leave shall read:

All full-time employees of the City hired before January 1, 1995 shall accrue twelve (12) ten (10) hours of sick leave per month of employment. All full time employees hired on or after January 1, 1995, shall accrue eight (8) hours of sick leave per month of employment. Sick leave shall be accrued each pay period and effective from the date of employment.

Section 4.00 on page 45 relating to Sick Leave shall read:

Part time employees hired before 01/01/95 who work twenty (20) hours or more per week accrue six (6) hours of leave per month. Part time employees hired on

or after 01/01/95 accrue four (4) hours of sick leave per month. Regular parttime employees working twenty (20) hours per week or more are entitled to onehalf (1/2) of the sick leave granted to full-time employees.

Section 4.01 A. on page 47 shall read:

Each full-time employee may, after accumulation of eight hundred forty (840) hours of unused sick leave, elect at his or her option to exchange that unused sick leave over and above seven hundred twenty (720) hours for pay at the rate of twenty four (24) twenty (20) sick leave hours for eight (8) hours of pay. Conversion of sick pay shall be in five (5) day increments. To effect said exchange, an employee electing same shall so notify the Finance Director in writing, whereupon said payment shall be made.

Section 4.04 I. 1. on page 51 shall read:

Full-time employees who work a minimum of forty (40) hours per week on a consistent year-round basis will be eligible for thirty-two (32) forty (40) hours of Personal Leave.

Section 5.07 A. 1. on page 82 shall read:

Certain City employees may be authorized to drive City-owned vehicles to and from work. Certain employees may be authorized in writing by the city Manager to use City-owned vehicles for personal business. Employees may be required to make payment to the City for miles driven to and from work or to pay the appropriate taxes for the benefit.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective on January 1, 2001. An emergency affecting the public welfare is declared to exist by virtue of the immediate need to reorganize the personnel of the City.
