25th DAY OF JANUARY, 1999.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE
NUMBER 32-98 WHICH ADOPTED ALL FEES ASSOCIATED
WITH THE GOLF CLUB AT YANKEE TRACE TO PROVIDE
FOR THE INCLUSION OF AN EXECUTIVE BUSINESS
MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance Number 32-98 is hereby amended with the italicized portions
added under Section 1 of said ordinance.

Executive Business Membership Program

Centerville Business Rate: \$4,200.00


Non-Centerville Business Rate: \$4,500.00

Executive Business Membership benefits include:

- Unlimited golf privileges for two designees.*
- Twenty-five complimentary rounds of golf for guests.*
- 10% reduction on guest green fees.*
- 60 day advance starting times for groups of 3 or more foursomes.*
- Monthly invoicing for golf and dining requirements.*
- Private locker and bag storage services.*
- Yankee Trace computerized handicap system.*
- 10% discount on regularly priced golf shop merchandise.*
- 50% discount on all Golf Academy programs.*

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall
become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby
declared to exist by virtue of the fact that this is essential for the orderly running of The Golf Club
at Yankee Trace.
