19th DAY OF APRIL, 1999.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CENTERVILLE  
MUNICIPAL CODE, PART 14 BUILDING AND HOUSING  
CODE, CHAPTER 1424 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE,  
AND ADOPTING THE 1999 ELECTRIC CODE-NFPA 70-1999  
BY REFERENCE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 5.06 of the Centerville City Charter, the [1996] 1999 Electric Code Code-NFPA 70-[1996] 1999 is hereby adopted and incorporated into the Centerville Municipal Code by reference for the purpose of regulating the installation and maintenance of electrical systems and appliances in the City.


Section 2. That Part 14, Section 1424, Subsection 1424.01(a), [and 1424.03(b)] of the Centerville Municipal Code are hereby amended as follows with the underlined portions added and the bracketed portions deleted:

**1424.01 [1996] 1999 EDITION ADOPTED; PURPOSE; FILE AND DISTRIBUTION COPIES.**


(a) Pursuant to Section 5.06 of the City Charter, that certain code known as the National Electric Code, [1996] 1999 edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association, save and except such portions as may be hereinafter deleted or amended, is hereby adopted by and for the City for the purpose of regulating the installation and maintenance of electrical systems and appliances in the City.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.


