AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE
PERSONNEL MANUAL FOR EMPLOYEES AT YANKEE TRACE.

WHEREAS, due to vast changes in personnel-related laws over the past several years, it became necessary to rewrite the City's Personnel Manual written in 1991, and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville contracted with Clemens, Nelson & Associates, Inc. for the preparation of a current Personnel Manual for employees associated with Yankee Trace.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City of Centerville Yankee Trace Personnel Manual, prepared by Clemens, Nelson & Associates, Inc., attached hereto, marked as exhibit "A" and incorporated herein be and is hereby adopted.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
