AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-85 BY EXTENDING THE  
EXPIRATION DATE FROM DECEMBER 31, 1999 TO JUNE 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 22-85 granting to the Dayton Power and Light Company  
a franchise to carry on the company's business of supplying natural gas to the City and  
such other purposes for which gas is now or may hereafter be used is due, by its terms, to  
expire on December 31, 1999; and

WHEREAS, there are many issues that remain to be resolved before the Council  
may consider a new franchise; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to extend said franchise for a period of six  
months upon the same terms and conditions as Ordinance 22-85 in order to allow the City  
and to the Dayton Power and Light Company to resolve those issues.

NOW THEREFORE

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 22-85 is hereby amended by deleting the  
expiration date of December 31, 1999 and substituting therefore an expiration date of  
June 30, 2000.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest  
date allowed by law.
