AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-86 DATED JULY 21, 1986, THE ZONING ORDINANCE BY REZONING 8.73 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP AGRICULTURE ZONE CLASSIFICATION TO CENTERVILLE R-1C, SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONE CLASSIFICATION.

## THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the zoning map attached to Ordinance Number 11-86 passed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July, 1986, and as subsequently amended, by, and the same is hereby revised as follows:

By changing the zoning of the following described property from Washington Township Agriculture Zone Classification to R-1c, Centerville Single-Family Residential Zone Classification:

Section 1. Situate in Section 35, Town 3, Range 5, Mrs, Washington Township, Montgomery County, Ohio and being two parcels of 8.73 acres more or less and described as follows:

> Starting at a point found by measuring from an existing 1" iron pipe at the southwest corner of Section 35 North 02° 15' 27" East 599.89 feet, more or less to the southwest corner of the land conveyed to Rendale John and Dianna Lee Honaker being the true point of beginning;

> thence from the point of beginning and continuing along said section line North 02° 48' 24" East, 769.96 feet to an iron pin being the northwest corner of the land conveyed to Yankee Trace Development, Inc;

thence departing said section line South 70° 30' 22" East, 570.15 feet to a found iron pin and being the northeast corner of the land conveyed to Yankee Trace Development, Inc;

thence South 02° 15' 27" West, 558.15 feet to a point being on the south property line of the land conveyed to Rendale John and Dianna Lee Honaker;

thence South 89° 33' 34" West, 553.58 feet more or less to the point of beginning containing 8.362 acres of land more or less.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the zoning map of the City of Centerville, Ohio, shall be revised to reflect this rezoning.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
