## ORDINANCE NO. <u>10-97</u> CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

## SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER <u>C. MARK KINGSEED</u> ON THE <u>2157</u> DAY OF <u>JULY</u>, 1997.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-86 DATED JULY 21, 1986, THE ZONING ORDINANCE BY REZONING 4.5381 ACRES MORE OR LESS, FROM CENTERVILLE I-1 CLASSIFICATION TO CENTERVILLE O-S CLASSIFICATION.

## THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the zoning map attached to Ordinance Number 11-86 passed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July, 1986, and as subsequently amended, by, and the same hereby is revised as follows:

By changing the zoning of the following described property from Centerville I-1 classification to Centerville O-S classification:

Situated in Section 14, town 2, Range 6, in the City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, being part of the 97.42 acre tract conveyed to Ralph G. Woodley and Ripalo, Inc. by deed recorded in MF #82-239E08 of the Montgomery County records, and being a tract of land more particularly described as follows:

Starting for reference at a monument box found at the intersection of the centerlines of Alexanderville & Bellbrook Road (State Route 725 centerline station 103+00) and Bigger Road (centerline station 0+00), said intersection also being the southwest corner of said Section 14; thence, north  $04\circ47'15''$  east with the centerline of Bigger Road (as shown on the centerline plat of Bigger Road, recorded in Plat Book 121, Page 19) a distance of 931.48 feet to centerline station 9+31.48; thence, south  $85\circ12'45''$  east, a distance of 55.00 feet to an iron pin set on the east right-of-way line of Bigger Road, a distance of 1222.24 feet to an iron pin set in the south line of the proposed Clyo Road extension; thence, south  $85\circ12'45''$  east, parallel with the centerline of Bigger Road a distance of 90.00 feet to an iron pin set on the north side of the said Clyo Road extension, said point being the point of beginning.

Thence, north 85°12'45" west, with said north line a distance of 13.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence, north 04047'15" east, with the east right-of-way line of Bigger Road a distance of 342.89 feet to an iron pin set at an angle point in said east rightof-way line; thence, north 04042'20" east, with said east right-of-way line, a distance of 33.90 feet to an iron pin set, said pin being 55.00 feet right of centerline station 26+20.41; thence, south 71°15'04" east, with the north line of said Woodley and Ripalo, Inc. tract a distance of 658.31 feet; thence, south 18°45'42" west, 304.89 feet; thence, north 71°14'18" west, 193.17 feet; thence with a curve to the left at a radius of 1056.10 feet, said curve having a length of 257.58 feet and being subtended by a chord bearing north 78°13'32" west, a distance of 256.94 feet; thence, north 85°12'45" west, 109.70 feet to the point of beginning.

Contains 4.5381 acres of land. Subject to all easements, restrictions and covenants of record.

Bearing used are based on the centerline monumentation of Bigger Road, Plat Book 121, Page 19.

The above description is taken from and in accordance with a plat dated October 15, 1990 by C.G. Hartman & Associates, Inc., C.G. Hartman, P.S. #7294 and a survey dated August, 1990 by McDougall Associates.

That the zoning map of the City of Centerville, Ohio shall be revised Section 2. to reflect this rezoning.

This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by Section 3. law.
