

ORDINANCE NO. 7-96
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER SUSAN LIENESCH ON THE
19th DAY OF AUGUST, 1996.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN
ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF
SURPLUS PROPERTY OF THE CITY HAVING AN
ESTIMATED VALUE OF MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND
DOLLARS (\$1,000.00).

WHEREAS, Sections 212.01 through 212.03 of the Centerville Municipal Code
provide for the disposal of surplus property of the City including that having a value of
more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville has determined that there are
occasions when an alternative procedure to that contained in said sections would better
benefit the Citizens of Centerville.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the
addition of the following Section 212.031:

*Section 212.031. ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURE FOR DISPOSAL
OF SURPLUS PROPERTY OF THE CITY HAVING AN
ESTIMATED VALUE OF MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND
DOLLARS (\$1,000.00.)*

*When the City Manager, in his or her sole discretion, determines
that circumstances exist which render the procedures set forth in
Sections 212.02 and 212.03 to be contrary to the best interests of
the City and its' citizens, the City Manager, with the consent of
Council, may adopt such alternative procedure for the disposal of
surplus property having an estimated value of more than one
thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in which event, the provisions of
Sections 212.02 and 212.03 shall not apply.*

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and
shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public
health, safety and morals is declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City presently

has surplus property having an estimated value of more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and it is known that alternative procedures for disposal will provide greater revenue to the City.
