

ORDINANCE NO. 6-95
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Brooks Compton ON THE
17th DAY OF April, 1995.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE NORTHERN PORTION OF
EAST VON DETTE CIRCLE TO GREEN ASH COURT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville has received a petition from all of the residents with property fronting on the northern portion of East Von Dette Circle asking that the name of said portion of East Von Dette Circle be changed to Green Ash Court; and

WHEREAS, §723.05 Ohio Revised Code permits the legislative authority of a municipal corporation to change the name of a street in said municipality when it finds that there are two or more streets with the same name; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that there are two streets in the municipality with the name of East Von Dette Circle, the one on which the said petitioners reside and one extending south from Mapleton Drive; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of this Council to change the name of East Von Dette Circle only in the area on which the properties of the petitioners have frontage and that the name of the said street extending south from Mapleton Drive shall remain East Von Dette Circle;

NOW THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:


Section 1. That the name of the street presently known as East Von Dette Circle which extends to the east and curves south from Marwyck Drive in this City is hereby changed to Green Ash Court for its entire present length.

Section 2. That the name of the street presently extending south from Mapleton Drive in this City and presently known as East Von Dette Circle shall remain East Von Dette Circle.


Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to furnish certified copies of this ordinance to the Montgomery County Auditor, Recorder, Engineer, Board of Elections, Sanitary Department and the United States Postal Service.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.


