AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 660.14(b)(1) OF THE  
CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY PROVIDING FOR SERVICE OF  
NOTICE UPON THE OWNER OF ANY LOT OR PARCEL OF LAND ON  
WHICH OFFENSIVE WEEDS, VINES OR GRASS ARE GROWING.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 660.14(b)(1) of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby  
amended by the addition of the following language appearing in italics:


The owner of any lot or parcel of land situated within the City, whether the same  
is improved or unimproved, vacant or occupied, within five days of receipt of  
written notice to do so, shall cut any offensive weeds, vines or grass on such lot  
or parcel or upon any street, public right-of-way or tree lawn abutting such lot  
or parcel. *Written notice may be served by certified mail, return receipt requested  
or by posting upon the premises. In the event a certified mailing is returned  
without delivery, service of written notice may thereafter be made by regular mail  
to the last known address of the owner of the said lot or parcel.*

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date  
allowed by law.
