

ORDINANCE NO. 19-95
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER J. V. Stone ON THE
11th DAY OF September, 1995.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES FOR LESSONS GIVEN BY GOLF PROFESSIONALS AT THE GOLF CLUB AT YANKEE TRACE.

WHEREAS, it is important for a community to provide its citizens with a balance of social, cultural and recreational activities that enrich the lives of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, it is desirous and in the best interest of the citizens of Centerville for the City to provide golf instruction as part of the overall golf recreational program at the City's municipal golf facility, the Golf Club at Yankee Trace, and

WHEREAS, the city-employed golf professionals provide golf instruction in addition to and beyond their normal work hours and responsibilities, and

WHEREAS, the golf professionals must be compensated for their instructional services outside of their normal compensation for regular duties;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Head Golf Professional, the Assistant Golf Professional and the Second Assistant Golf Professional and any other position designated by the City Manager to assist in providing golf instruction, shall be entitled to the compensation as provided below:

- a. An amount equal to no more than 75% of the gross revenue, or fees, from each lesson or series of lessons provided by the golf professional or instructor. The exact percentage shall be determined by the City Manager. This amount will be subject to the standard pay deductions including Public Employees Retirement System, Federal, State and Local Taxes, Medicare and the like.
- b. All fees for lessons shall be collected by the City and properly accounted for as golf operations revenues.
- c. These provisions shall be effective retroactively beginning March 1, 1995 and shall remain in effect until December 31, 1995.


Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting the public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that it is essential to provide appropriate compensation to golf professionals giving instructions as part of the overall golf recreational program at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace.


