AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES FOR INDOOR LESSONS GIVEN BY GOLF PROFESSIONALS AT THE GOLF CLUB AT YANKEE TRACE.

WHEREAS, it is important for a community to provide its citizens with a balance of social, cultural and recreational activities that enrich the lives of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, it is desirous and in the best interest of the citizens of Centerville for the City to provide indoor golf instruction as part of the overall golf recreational program at the City's municipal golf facility, the Golf Club at Yankee Trace, and

WHEREAS, the city-employed golf professionals provide indoor golf instruction as part of and in addition to their normal work hours and responsibilities, and

WHEREAS the golf professionals should be compensated for their instructional services;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

- Section 1. The Golf Professionals, and any other position designated by the City Manager to assist in providing indoor golf instruction, shall be entitled to the compensation as provided below:
 - a. An amount equal to no more than 50% of the gross lesson revenue generated by each professional, over a base amount of \$1,400.00 of gross lesson revenue generated by each professional per calendar month. This compensation will be subject to the standard pay deductions including Public Employees Retirement System, Federal, State and Local Taxes, Medicare and the like. The base amount of lesson revenue over which pros earn 50% of the revenue, may be adjusted by the City Manager.
 - b. All fees for lessons shall be collected by the City and properly accounted for as golf operations revenues.
 - c. These provisions shall be effective retroactively beginning November 1, 1995.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting the public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that it is essential to provide appropriate compensation to golf professionals giving instructions as part of the overall golf recreational program at the Golf Club at Yankee Trace.
