

ORDINANCE NO. 44-95
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER JAMES REPERT ON THE
15th DAY OF JANUARY, 1996.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES FOR
OUTDOOR LESSONS GIVEN BY GOLF PROFESSIONALS AT THE
GOLF CLUB AT YANKEE TRACE.

WHEREAS, it is important for a community to provide its citizens with a balance of social, cultural and recreational activities that enrich the lives of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, it is desirous and in the best interest of the citizens of Centerville for the City to provide golf instruction as part of the overall golf recreational program at the City's municipal golf facility, the Golf Club at Yankee Trace, and

WHEREAS, the city-employed golf professionals provide golf instruction in addition to their normal work hours and responsibilities, and

WHEREAS the golf professionals should be compensated for their instructional services;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Golf Professionals, and any other position designated by the City Manager to assist in providing outdoor golf instruction, shall be entitled to the compensation as provided below:

a. An amount equal to no more than 75% of the gross lesson revenue generated by each professional. The exact percentage shall be determined by the City Manager. This compensation will be subject to the standard pay deductions including Public Employees Retirement System, Federal, State and Local Taxes, Medicare and the like.

b. All fees for lessons shall be collected by the City and properly accounted for as golf operations revenues.

c. These provisions shall be effective beginning March 1, 1996.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
