AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF SOUTH METRO
DRIVE TO SOUTH METRO PARKWAY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville has received a petition signed by property owners within the municipal corporation and abutting on South Metro Drive, which is located north of Thomas Paine Parkway and east of Bigger Road, asking that the name of South Metro Drive be changed to South Metro Parkway, and


WHEREAS, a municipality has the power to change a street name upon such petition by virtue of Section 723.04 Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the name of "South Metro Drive" is hereby changed to "South Metro Parkway" for its entire length.


SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council and City Engineer are hereby authorized and directed to cause this name change to become a matter of public record with the proper offices of Montgomery County, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
