

ORDINANCE NO. 10-91

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER James Suger ON THE
15th DAY OF July, 1991.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE LIMITING THE CITY'S
PERS "PICK UP" TO ONLY FULL TIME EMPLOYEES
AND CERTAIN REGULAR PART-TIME EMPLOYEES.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the provisions of Ordinances 45-84,
2-85 and 17-85 which generally provide that the City will
"pick up" the employees' portion of the mandatory
contributions to the Public Employees' Retirement System and
the Police and Firemen's Disability and Pension Fund shall
have no application to any regular part-time employee working
twenty (20) hours a week or less who may be hired by the City
after June 30, 1991 or to any seasonal employees as defined in
Section II, LL of the City of Centerville Personnel Rules and
Regulations.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure affecting public health and safety and,
therefore, shall become effective immediately upon passage.
An emergency exists by virtue of the fact that recent
legislative changes to the Public Employees' Retirement System
now include all part-time employees and all seasonal employees
which were not previously covered.
