CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Bernard Scuples ON THE  
20th DAY OF November, 1989.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION  
OF EAST WHIPP ROAD TO OLD WHIPP COURT IN THE  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 723.05, Ohio Revised Code,  
in the opinion of the Council of the City of Centerville there is  
good cause to realign a portion of East Whipp Road to intersect  
Wilmington Pike at Feedwire Road, and

WHEREAS, the realignment of a portion of East Whipp  
Road necessitates changing the name of a portion of the existing  
roadway to Old Whipp Court to avoid two roadways having the same  
name in the City of Centerville, Ohio.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY  
ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the portion of existing East Whipp  
Road from its point of realignment for approximately 680 feet  
east to its termination is hereby changed to Old Whipp Court.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council and City Engineer  
are hereby authorized and directed to cause this name change to  
become a matter of public record with the proper offices of  
Montgomery County, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from  
and after the earliest date allowed by law.
