AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND INDEMNIFICATION
RIGHTS TO CITY EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:


SECTION 1. The City shall defend its employees, appointed and elected officials, in and from any and all suits, claims, charges and demands based upon or arising from action or services such persons have taken or performed within the scope of his or her responsibilities, including action or services taken or performed as a member of non-city boards, commissions or organizations to the extent the participation in such outside organizations results from the person's status as an employee or an official of Centerville and is undertaken as a service for or a benefit to the City of Centerville.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
