

ORDINANCE NO. 22-81

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Sally Beale ON
THE 18th DAY OF January, 1988.

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, IN THE MATTER OF THE MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND OPERATION OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 675.

WHEREAS, the public interest requires that the Department of Transportation maintain and keep in repair interstate highways within the City of Centerville, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said City be and such consent is hereby given to the Director of Transportation to maintain and repair said Interstate Highway and to bear the costs thereof, inclusive of the furnishing of electric power for sign lighting and highway lighting.

SECTION II. That the City, hereby proposes to cooperate with the State of Ohio and will bear the cost, and

(a) Maintain and repair all grade separated municipal streets, exclusive of bridge structures within the right of way limits of the interstate highway.

(b) Maintain and repair the wearing surface on bridges carrying municipal streets over the interstate highway. Changes in type or depth of wearing surface will not be permitted without prior approval by the State. The State of Ohio will maintain the bridge structures (including the concrete deck and approach slabs) carrying municipal streets over the interstate highway. The City will maintain the asphalt overlay on the bridges.

(c) Remove snow and place abrasives and chemicals for ice control on all grade separated municipal streets, inclusive of bridges carrying such streets over the interstate highway.

(d) Maintain and repair all service roads, drainage structures, and other roadway items located outside the fenced portion of the interstate highway.

(e) Furnish, install, maintain and repair all signs, pavement markings and other traffic control devices on the intersecting local streets at interchanges or on overpass or

underpass roadways in accordance with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices; excepting state route interchange approach signs.


(f) Maintain and repair (including furnishing electric power) highway lighting units on intersected local streets at interchanges and on overpass or underpass roadways; as mutually approved in the future.

SECTION III. That the Director of Transportation shall be the issuing authority for permits to use or occupy interstate highway right-of-way and permits for the movement of oversize and overweight loads over interstate highways.

SECTION IV. That traffic control signals will not be installed at the intersections of ramp terminals and the local streets without prior approval by the State.

SECTION V. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


