

ORDINANCE NO. 6-86

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Brooks Compton, ON THE
17th DAY OF March, 1986.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 191.15 (b) (1) OF THE
CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY CHANGING THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS
OF THE BOARD OF TAX APPEALS.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 191.15 (b) (1) of the
Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

A Board of Tax Appeals, consisting of three
(3) representative residents of the City,
not otherwise employed by the City, to be
appointed by Council for [a term of one year]
terms of three (3) years, is hereby created.
Initially, members shall be appointed for
1, 2 and 3 year terms respectively. Thereafter,
members shall be appointed to and shall serve
for three (3) year terms.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective
from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
