AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING MEMBERS OF  
A COMMISSION TO REVIEW THE CENTERVILLE CHARTER  
AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REVISION.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 12.04 (b) of the Centerville City Charter the following persons are hereby appointed to a Commission to review the existing Charter and make such recommendations as said Commission may see fit for revision: J. V. Stone, Nora E. Lake, John A. Davis, James L. Hussey, G. Dean Brandt, Kent E. Bromagen, George W. Chamberlain, Gale F. Baker, and David L. Hall.

Section 2. Said Commission shall submit its report to Council not later than August 1, 1984.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by reason of the fact that the provisions of the Centerville Charter require that Council appoint said Commission at the first meeting in January, 1984.
