AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF EAST AVENUE TO EAST DRIVE  
IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, has received a petition from the owners of all lots fronting on East Avenue requesting the change of the name of East Avenue to East Drive for the reason that East Avenue for many years has been known as East Drive and this has recently led to much confusion.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 723.04 Ohio Revised Code, a City Council may, by ordinance, change a street name upon hearing for good cause shown; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville hereby determines that there is good cause for said change;

NOW THEREFORE


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the name East Avenue, for its entire length is hereby changed to East Drive.


SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council and City Engineer are hereby authorized and directed to cause this name change to become a matter of public record with the proper offices of Montgomery County, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


