AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 15-61 AND 41-77 RELATING
TO SIDEWALK SALES IN BUSINESS DISTRICTS.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 22, Subsection 0 of Ordinance 15-61 as
amended by Ordinance 41-77 is hereby amended as follows:

- (3) No more than five of the sales permitted in
Subsection (1) above may be held by the owner
or operator of the business described in
Subsection (1) above in any one calendar
year.
- (4) Merchandise offered for sale as permitted in
Subsection (1) above shall only be that
normally offered for sale by the business owner
or operator who is conducting the sale.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after
the earliest date allowed by law.
