THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 921.04 of the Centerville Municipal Code, set forth as follows, is hereby repealed:


[Any person owning or having charge of land within the City, shall keep such property free and clear from all nocuous weeds and rank vegetation and shall be required to cut all such weeds and vegetation on the lots owned or controlled by him at least twice in every year, once between June 1 and June 15 and once between August 1 and August 15. (ORD. 5-65. Passed 4-5-65.)]

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date allowed by law.
