AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 105 OF THE
CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO
PUBLIC CONTRACTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7.07 of the Centerville
Charter the Council may, by ordinance, establish procedures for
competitive bidding and awarding of public contracts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its powers as granted by the
Centerville Charter the Council has enacted Chapter 105 of the
Centerville Municipal Code which it now desires to amend;

NOW THEREFORE:


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 105.01 of the Centerville
Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:


(d) Anything contained in Subsections (a), (b)
and (c) notwithstanding, the City Manager
is authorized to purchase any equipment
without bid, if said equipment has an
anticipated life of more than two years and
costs no more than Fourteen Thousand Dollars
(\$14,000.00) provided he shall first have
obtained the written consent thereto from
either the Mayor, Deputy Mayor or the
Chairman of the Finance Committee of
Council.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the
earliest date allowed by law.
