AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1119.02 OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY PROVIDING FOR THE EXPIRATION OF RECORD PLAN APPROVALS IN THE EVENT SAME IS NOT RECORDED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF FINAL APPROVAL.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 1119.02 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:


(g) Any final approval of the plat by the Planning Commission shall expire and be void if the Record Plan has not been recorded with the Office of the County Recorder within 180 days after the date of final approval by the Planning Commission.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


