AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 22-80 BY INCREASING THE MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT PROVISION OF THE PERSONNEL POLICY FOR SOUTH MONTGOMERY HUMAN SERVICES FROM FIFTEEN CENTS PER MILE TO TWENTY CENTS PER MILE.

The Municipality of Centerville hereby ordains:

Section 1.

That Article III, Section 5 of the Personnel Policy of South Montgomery Human Services as contained in Ordinance 22-80 is hereby amended as follows:


Any employee using his/her personal automobile for official business will be reimbursed for mileage at the rate of [~~15¢~~] 20¢ per mile and for parking upon presentation of receipts.


Section 2.
