AN ORDINANCE


FIXING THE PRICE WHICH THE DAYTON POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, MAY CHARGE FOR ELECTRIC LIGHT FURNISHED TO THE PUBLIC GROUNDS, STREETS, LANES, ALLEYS AND AVENUES IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-ONE (21) MONTHS COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF APRIL 1981, AND ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER 1982, AND DETERMINING THE MANNER IN WHICH SAID LIGHTING MAY BE FURNISHED, PROVIDED AND PAID FOR, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 45-80 SO THAT ITS PROVISIONS SHALL EXPIRE ON THE 31ST DAY OF MARCH 1981.

This Acceptance is filed with you in accordance with and in conformity to the terms of Said Ordinance, passed by your Honorable Body on the 18th day of May, 1981.
