
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPOINT JACK LANGRECK TO THE
SISTER CITY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO,
TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF JAMES ALBRECHT.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Jack Langreck is hereby appointed as a member of the
Sister City Committee for the City of Centerville, Ohio, to fill the unexpired
term of James Albrecht.


Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency
affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact
that the City of Centerville, for the good of its citizens has determined

Langreck to the Committee is essential in order to undertake activities
of the Committee to be immediately commenced.


