## ORDINANCE NO. 22-SI

## CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 913.02 AND 915.06 OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO FEES AND BONDS FOR STREET AND CURB CUTS.

The municipality of Centerville hereby ordains;

Section 1. That Section 913.02 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

PERMIT FEE; REQUIRED DEPOSIT.

The person, firm or corporation desiring to acquire a permit to do any of the acts specified in Section 913.01 shall apply to the City Manager. Before the City Manager shall issue such permit, the applicant shall pay a permit fee of [twenty dollars (\$20.00)] thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) to cover necessary administrative and engineering expenses and deposit the sum of [two hundred dollars (\$200.00)] two hundred-fifty dollars (\$250.00), or a sum computed at the rate of ten dollars (\$10.00) per square yard proposed by the applicant to be excavated, whichever sum is greater. The permit fee and the deposit so required shall be paid in cash, certified check or postal money order to the Finance Director and thereafter the permit shall be issued.

Section 2. That Section 915.06 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

⊢ ∀ Fees for curb cuts are as follows: for each curb cut: [twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)] thirty-five dollars (\$35.00). Section 3 This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
