

ORDINANCE NUMBER 6-80
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Leonard Stubbs ON THE 3rd
DAY OF March, 1980.

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE SPEED LIMIT ON WILMINGTON
PIKE.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 4511.21 provides for modi-
fications of speed limits, at the discretion of local authorities, but subject
to limitations set forth in the above chapter;

WHEREAS, the part of Wilmington Pike between Brown Road and
Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road (SR725) has only widely spaced access drives,
leading to and from adjacent properties;

WHEREAS, Wilmington Pike is a through highway located in both
Sugar creek Township, Greene County and within the corporation limit of the
City of Centerville, the corporation line coinciding with the centerline of
Wilmington Pike, and Centerville controlling the west half of the through
highway;

WHEREAS, a uniform speed limit for both sides of the throughway
would be advantageous, and;

WHEREAS, it was agreed by the Greene County Engineer and by repre-
sentatives of Sugar creek Township that they would recommend posting of a
speed limit of 40 miles per hour on their side of the throughway, if
Centerville enacted similar legislation;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the speed limit on Wilmington Pike between Brown
Road and Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road (SR725) be set at 40 miles per hour.


Section 2. The City Manager is hereby directed to cause installa-
tion of new speed limit signs to that effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after
the earliest date allowed by law.


