AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A COMMUNITY FISCAL ANALYSIS COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR THE STRUCTURE AND ORGANIZATION OF SAID COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING DUTIES OF SAID COMMITTEE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

 $\frac{\text{SECTION 1.}}{(21) \text{ persons, including a Chairman, to serve for three (3) years staggered terms. Initial terms will be for one, two or three years and chosen by lot. Appointments shall be made to insure broad representation both geographically and technically. The Mayor, Members of Council and the City Manager shall serve as ex-officio members of the committee. The committee may adopt such rules of procedure as may be necessary for the effective conduct of its business and which are not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.$

SECTION 2. Purpose and Charge. The Community Fiscal Analysis Committee created in Section 1 hereof, shall review, analyze and make recommendations to the City Council and City Manager on all matters concerning the fiscal structure, condition, practices and policies of the City of Centerville. Inherent in this fiscal review is the responsibility to also review and analyze current and proposed types, levels, and financing services and programs and to make recommendations regarding various alternatives involved. Each year, in concert with the City Council Finance Committee and the City Manager, the Committee shall review the annual budget proposal and make recommendations to the City Council.
