

ORDINANCE NO. 5-79

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN More Lake on the 19th day of
January, 1979.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE CONVEYANCE OF TWO CENTERVILLE PARKS
TO THE CENTERVILLE-WASHINGTON PARK DIS-
TRICT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville has determined that
it no longer has a need of the following described parks for Municipal purposes;
and

WHEREAS, the Centerville-Washington Park District, a political sub-
division of the State of Ohio, is ready, willing and able to assume ownership
and maintenance of said parks;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City of Centerville convey to the Centerville-Washington
Park District two parks owned by the City of Centerville and described as
follows:

PARCEL 1

Situated in the City of Centerville, County of Mont-
gomery and State of Ohio and being more particularly
described as follows:

Being Lot Number 35 of Terrace Villa Plat as recorded
in Plat Book 87, Page 57 of the Plat Records of Mont-
gomery County, Ohio, subject to all easements, con-
ditions and restrictions of record and all legal high-
ways.

PARCEL 2

Situated in the City of Centerville, County of Mont-
gomery and State of Ohio and being more particularly
described as follows:


Being Lot Number 120 of Black Oak Forest, Section 2
as recorded in Plat Book 102, Page 17 of the Plat Records
of Montgomery County, Ohio, subject to all easements,
conditions and restrictions of record and all legal high-
ways.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City of Centerville are hereby
authorized and directed to execute deeds for the aforesaid parks to the Centerville-
Washington Park District, to deliver said deeds to said Park District and to do
any and every other thing necessary in order to affectuate said conveyances.

Section 3. That if the use of the aforesaid parcels ever ceases to be for park purposes, the ownership of said parcels shall revert to the City of Centerville.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


