16th DAY OF July, 1979.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 303.01 OF
THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY CHANGING
THE PENALTY TO COMPLY WITH SIMILAR PRO-
VISIONS OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 303.01 of the Centerville Municipal Code is
hereby amended as follows:

COMPLIANCE WITH LAWFUL ORDER OF POLICE OFFICER:

FLEEING


- (a) No person shall fail to comply with any
lawful order or direction of any police officer
invested with authority to direct, control or
regulate traffic.
- (b) No person shall operate a motor vehicle so as
to willfully elude or flee a police officer after
receiving a visible or audible signal from a
police officer to bring his motor vehicle to
a stop. (ORC 4511.02)
- (c) Whoever violates subsection (b) hereof is
guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the
earliest date allowed by law.


