AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15-1961,
THE ZONING ORDINANCE BY DEFINING PROMOTIONAL
DEVICES AND PROHIBITING THEIR USE IN ALL
ZONING DISTRICTS.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 5, Definitions of Ordinance 15-1961,
The Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by the addition of the
following:


Promotional Device - any beacon, signaling light, spotlight
or similar apparatus, equipment or device used or designed for use
in connection with the promotion of the opening, reopening,
anniversary, special event or ordinary business operation of any
business or retail or wholesale operation except a light which is
used solely to illuminate a sign or building.

Section 2. That Section 32 of Ordinance 15-1961, The Zoning
Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following:


D. Promotional Device - Any and all promotional devices
shall be prohibited in all zoning districts.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and
after the earliest date allowed by law.
