ORDINANCE NO. 42-79CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Russell Sweetnen ON THE 1st

DAY OF October

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 351 and 1511 OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY GRANTING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE POWER TO ESTABLISH FIRE LANES AND TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF VEHICLES THEREIN.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

That Chapter 1511 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

Section 1511.06 FIRE LANES

The City Manager, upon the advice of the Chief Fire Prevention Officer of the City, is hereby authorized to establish fire lanes upon public ways or upon private property regularly used by vehicular traffic and to adopt rules and regulations pertaining to same.

That Chapter 351 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

Section 351.16

- (a) No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle within an area designated as a fire lane pursuant to Section 1511.06.
- (b) Whenever any police officer finds a vehicle unattended in any fire lane designated pursuant to Section 1511.06, such officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle to the nearest garage or other place of safety, and said vehicle may not be removed therefrom until the owner of said vehicle has paid for the cost of its removal and storage.

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
